Dear Parents and Carers,

Reminder: Items Brought into School. We have noticed an increasing number of items being brought into school that should not be here. Please be reminded that toys, lip balms, pens, writing books, and any other personal items should not be brought to school under any circumstances. These items can cause distractions, get lost, or create unnecessary disputes between children. The only items that should be in school are those that have been directly agreed upon with the class teacher.

Mobile Phones in School. If your child needs to bring a mobile phone to school, a permission form must be filled out, and the phone must be handed into the office upon arrival. This ensures that devices are kept safe and not used inappropriately during the school day.

School Uniform Policy. Children must wear the correct school uniform on the appropriate days. This includes suitable footwear – trainers are only permitted on designated PE days. On all other days, children must wear sensible, dark school shoes. The school office will be contacting parents of children who are not following the uniform policy. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately each day to maintain school standards.

Safer Internet Day – Next week, we will be participating in Safer Internet Day, an important event dedicated to educating children about online safety. We will be discussing responsible internet use, protecting personal information, and making smart choices when online. Parents are encouraged to continue these discussions at home to reinforce the importance of staying safe online.
