

## Maths



**Money:** Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p)

Combine amounts to make a particular value

Find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.

**Multiplication and Division:** Shows that multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and division of one number by another cannot.

Recalls and uses multiplications and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables. Recognises odd and even numbers.

**Fractions:** Be able to find and recognise halves and quarters of shapes and amounts.

Connect unit fraction to equal sharing and grouping.

Count in halves and quarters.

**Time:** Tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes.

**Reasoning and problem solving** involving all of the areas above.

## Science



**Animals including humans-**In this topic, children will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air). The children will also learn about life cycles and look at how animal babies grow and change.

## Wider Curriculum

**History:** In history, the children will learn all about the 'Great Fire of London'. They will investigate evidence sources and learn about the reasons why the fire spread so quickly.

**Geography:** The children will identify the continents, countries and seas of the world.

**Art:** In Art, the children will design, create and evaluate their own painted artwork representing the 'Great Fire of London'.

**Music:** In Music, the children will continue to learn about African music and learning the song 'Hands, Feet, Heart'.

## PE

During Spring Term, the children in Year 2 will be developing their throwing and catching skills in different games. They will then use these skills with the NUFC coach where they will be focusing on a range of ball skills.

## PSHE



During their PSHE lessons, the children will be focusing on the following subjects: Dreams & Goals and Healthy Me.

## English



**Writing:** A range of different genres will be explored this term to enable the children to utilize their grammatical skills with purpose. The children will be writing traditional tales, poetry, diary entries and persuasive letters.

**Reading/Phonics:** In reading/phonics lessons, children will learn all of their phonetic sounds and will develop their speed and confidence when reading independently. Children will also focus on developing their comprehension skills using a range of fiction and non-fiction texts.

**Spelling:** Children will work on learning all of the statutory Year 2 spellings. They will also continue to learn a range of spelling rules helping them to accurately use a range of prefixes and suffixes.
